The initiative to form the Anarchist Federation in Greece, completing the preparatory process, and a few days prior to the founding congress of the Federation (3-4/10/2015), makes public the text "ORGANIZATIONAL, TACTICAL, AND STRATEGIC GOALS OF THE FEDERATION IN THE CURRENT CIRCUMSTANCES".

The jointly agreed text of the 21 points includes permanent, short-term and long-term targets. The aim of the text is to coordinate theory and action of the anarchist groups who comprise the Federation, and to act as a trigger for a responsible and organized intervention in the broader class and social struggle, the public space, the everyday life, spaces of education and work, moments of conflict and moments of decision. The decision of the groups for cohesion, consolidated criteria, coordinated and concerted practices is listed in the text of the 21 points as a collective commitment, while preserving the autonomy and the specifities of the action by each group in the Anarchist Federation.

Anarchist Federation of Greece: Organizational, Tactical, and Strategic Goals in the Present Circumstances

1. Familiarization and evaluation of the structure, operation, and tools of the organization, by the groups that constitute the federation.

2. Expansion: inclusion of new groups, fortification of existing groups by bringing in new people, geographical expansion through all of Greece with the creation of linked sections in every region.

3. Organized presence of the federation in all the big events in the streets (1st of May, Polytechnic anniversary, workers' strikes, etc.).

4. Ability of the federation to respond to emergency needs of the struggle and in moments of crisis.

5. Qualitative improvement of the relations and cohesion among the participating groups. Sharing of experiences, solidarity, cooperation, comprehension of the equality among all the groups of the federation.

6. Creation of infrastructure for nutrition, healthcare, and self-defense, with the perspective of covering our basic needs and also generating experiences and skills for responding to possible humanitarian crises in the coming circumstances.

7. Developing economic resources to support material and technical infrastructure, and to sustain interventions in the struggle.

8. Development of specific methodologies of assymetrical intervention that allow a great political impact with few resources.

9. Achieving completeness and quality in all the practical and technical mediums of the federation, as well as in our public appearance.

10. Active support and horizontal cooperation with other forces in the anarchist movement, across a range of circumstances, according to our political commonalities and the needs of the struggle.

11. Support for self-organized social, local, and class initiatives and counter- institutions with libertarian characteristics.

12. Development of affinities, organizational bonds, and the manifestation of common struggles with international anarchist movements and libertarian social movements, in the Balkans, in the Mediterranean, in Europe, and all over the world.

13. Discourse and presence on the central political stage and in response to the topics that this stage produces as "current affairs". The Anarchist Federation, as one of the cutting edges of the anarchist movement, intervenes in a distinctive and recognizable

way, promoting its own perspectives and propagating anarchist forms of struggle.

14. Beyond the central political stage, on the local scale, in the class struggle, in any social sphere, or in any event of the struggle, the organization spreads, clarifies, and updates the anarchist theses, attempting to give answers and specific proposals.

15. Giving special importance to the interventions and the propaganda targeting the youth in the places where they gather (schools, universities, stadiums, etc.).

16. Propagation in all social fields, in the workplace, in the neighborhoods, in negation of the political stage, and also inside the anarchist movement, of the ideas and practices of organizing the movement and creating anarchist groups.

17. The deconstruction of fascist/racist discourses, direct conflict with fascist/racist practices, on the subject of immigration. The promotion of solidarity and class unity among locals and immigrants.

18. Resistance, criticism, and questioning, not only of the Greek state and the domestic bourgeoisie, but also of the interstate, imperialist formations, such as the European Union, NATO, IMF, etc., from the perspective of internationalist solidarity and the revolutionary community of the oppressed and exploited ones, independent of borders across the world.

19. Planning and intensifying the political conflict with the Left and any political power that sustains the delusions of class cooperation or of alternative solutions for social emancipation within the framework of State and capitalism, in whatever form.

20. Propagating the idea, and supporting it directly and practically, of a mass libertarian class-war syndicalist organization of the working class and all the other exploited classes or social layers, aiming towards the revolution, communism, and social self-organization.

21. Organizing and initiating the process for the production and constant updating of a transitional revolutionary program that will attempt to break down and resynthesize, on the one hand, the imminent possibilities for a self-organized libertarian and classless society, and on the other hand, strategies of struggle for achieving these possibilities.
